OVERVIEW:

On 11th July 2022, Abellio London Bus announced that it had opened the doors to its brand-new depot for West London. The Hayes depot will be the home of new state-of the art EV buses.

Enel X Way electrified the depot complete with the installation, maintenance and servicing of six 300kW high-powered Enel X Way charging stations for the EV buses. The charging infrastructure is fast and smart, leveraging technology to maximise efficiency such as charging at off-peak times.

Dawley Road is one of multiple EV bus depot projects in London, with others opening in Battersea and Beddington.

CASE STUDY

APPROACH:

Low voltage distribution equipment was designed and built by Specialist Switchgear systems using Terasaki Air and Moulded Case Circuit Breakers. The incoming Air Circuit Breakers were rated at 3200A and included a key interlocking scheme to manage alternative supply sources.

Cleaner EV Ltd managed the scheme design, carried out the engineering, procurement, construction, installation and co-ordination with energy supplier Enel X Way.

RESULTS:

 6 x 300kW EV bus chargers supplied with electrical power, switching and protection.
